4. The following week we go upcountry to visit more family. On our way we see fields<sup>2</sup> of green plants. "The vegetation you see is tea plants," Grandpa tells us. "Kenya exports a lot of tea," he adds.
5. Every year in July and August, over one million wildebeests<sup>3</sup>, zebras and gazelles migrate from the Serengeti in Tanzania to the Maasai Mara in Kenya. It's called The Great Migration – the seventh wonder<sup>4</sup> of the world!
